In order for a family motion to be heard in the summer, it must fall under the following criteria:

- New matter – where there is no order with regard to custody, maintenance and access;
- Summer access motion;
- Matters involving urgent Motions;
- Order suspending enforcement of support;
- For the motions during July and August only, matters on Friday afternoon will be set from 1:30 p.m. to end by 3:30 p.m.

Variation, contempt, appeal or procedural matters are not considered urgent, and generally will not be heard during July and August. Counsel may submit correspondence to me expressing the need for the aforementioned matters to be heard and it will be referred to the Duty Judge for decision.
