RE: MOTION BRIEFS ON CIVIL UNCONTESTED LIST

Inquiries have been made about whether or not a change of practice has been directed or implemented in respect to matters appearing on the Civil Uncontested List. Those inquiries relate to whether there is now a new practice requiring that a motion brief be filed prior to the obtaining of the relief or order sought.

It should be understood that in certain matters of complexity or uniqueness, it is open to the presiding judge on the Civil Uncontested List to request additional materials to substantiate or clarify a request for relief or an order. Examples of such materials may include, but are not limited to, relevant legislation and regulations. Given the uncontested nature of this List and the principle of proportionality, such additional materials do not include the filing of motion briefs.
