COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH OF MANITOBA

RE: EXHIBITS ON BAIL REVIEWS IN COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH

When an applicant seeks to review a judicial interim release order made previously, the notice of motion must be accompanied by a legible copy of any exhibits, capable of reproduction, that were filed in the judicial interim release hearing or in any previous review proceeding. If counsel require access to the exhibits filed at the judicial interim release hearing, they may contact the Exhibit Officer (204-945-3028). If these exhibits are not filed as directed, it may be that the hearing does not proceed on a contested basis.

The Practice Direction titled "Exhibits on Bail Reviews in Court of Queen's Bench" issued May 27, 2015, is revoked.
