## PRACTICE DIRECTION REGARDING THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY IN CIVIL LITIGATION

At a meeting on June 3, 2011, the judges of the Court of Queen's Bench approved and adopted the above Practice Directions, which were developed by a committee composed of judges and lawyers.

The Practice Direction regarding Discovery of Electronic Documents is intended to guide lawyers, parties and the judiciary in the e-discovery process. The Practice Direction regarding the Use of Technology in Civil Litigation is intended to provide guidance regarding the use of technology in civil litigation; much of this Practice Direction addresses the problem of the exchange of discoverable documents in incompatible electronic formats, and it includes default standards for document exchange in electronic format.
